Topics	P-Talks in 2024 will focus on "Exploring New Challenges of Productivity," involving relevant resource persons, business leaders, and entrepreneurs. P-Insights reports will also be published by the APO.
Outcome	Increased understanding and awareness of current and emerging trends in productivity enhancement and innovation, improved knowledge and skills related to productivity tools and techniques that can be applied in organizations, and improved collaboration and knowledge sharing among participants and stakeholders.
