Currently, 18 affiliated district level member unions procure around 25 million liters of milk per day from 18,565 village level dairy cooperative societies through 3.6 million milk producer members. Amul Federation manages the

entire value chain from Cow to Consumer to achieve its mission of giving farmer 'the best price' for his milk and consumer 'value for money' for the products. Our commitment to quality and productivity was recently recognised by the Asian Productivity Organization, Tokyo, Japan by conferring the prestigious Regional Award as Asia Pacific Productivity Champion. The award is conferred to eligible individuals who have significantly contributed to advancing the productivity movement in the Asia-Pacific Region.

NATIONAL PRODUCTIVITY COUNCIL CERTIFICATION BODY



NPC develops Bharat 4.0 mobile app





NPC along with UNEP discusses micro plastic pollution with NMCG


