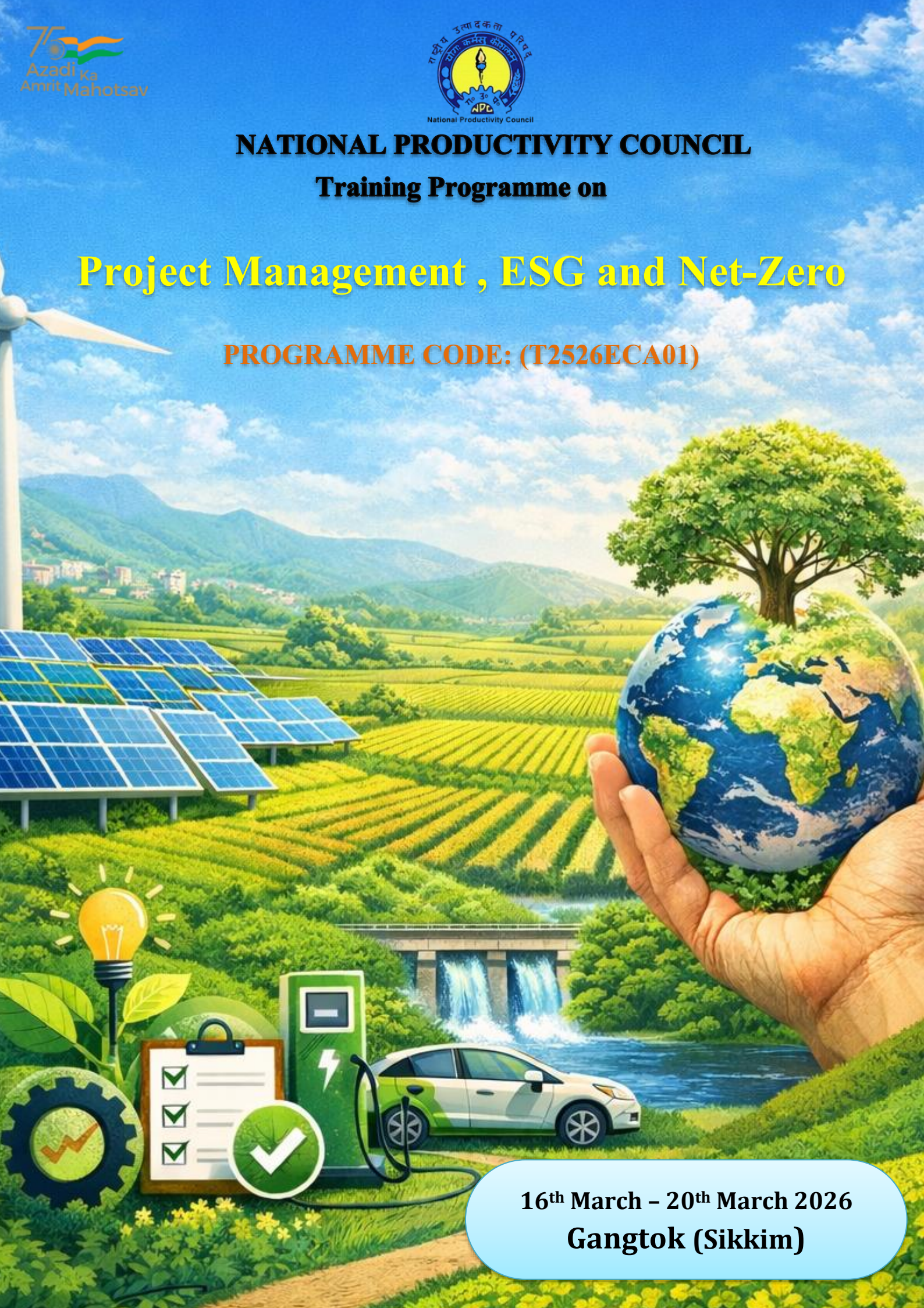

1. ABOUT NPC

The National Productivity Council (NPC) is an autonomous organization under the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT), Ministry of Commerce & Industry, Government of India. 2. PROGRAMME THEME

India is steadily progressing towards a cleaner, greener, and more resilient development pathway. Achieving sustainability and Net-Zero goals, however, depends not only on policies and technologies, but equally on how projects are planned, managed, and delivered on the ground.

This training programme is designed to help participants understand sustainability, ESG, and Net-Zero concepts in simple and practical terms, and to demonstrate how these principles can be effectively embedded into project management processes. The focus is on translating sustainability commitments into measurable, on-ground results through structured planning, execution, monitoring, and governance of projects.

Participants will gain insights into how various sectors contribute to emissions, resource use, and climate risks, and how **improved project design and execution** can reduce costs, enhance efficiency, manage risks, and minimise environmental and social impacts. Special emphasis will be placed on **aligning projects with India's national priorities**, including the **Net-Zero 2070 commitment, ESG and BRSR requirements, and sustainable development goals**, while ensuring that sustainability integration remains **practical, actionable, and not overly complex**. By the end of the programme, participants will gain **clear and actionable insights** on how to:

- *Plan and manage projects that deliver tangible sustainability and Net-Zero outcomes*
- *Integrate ESG considerations into everyday project decisions*
- *Reduce project risks, improve performance, and create long-term value*
- *Contribute meaningfully to India's climate commitments and development objectives*

This programme is ideally suited for **project managers, government officials, professionals from PSUs and corporates, consultants, and practitioners** involved in planning, implementing, or overseeing projects who seek to make sustainability and Net-Zero goals work effectively in practice.

3. LEARNING OBJECTIVES

This training programme aims to build a structured and practical understanding among participants to effectively plan, implement, and manage projects aligned with sustainability and Net-Zero goals. Specifically, participants will be able to:

- Develop a clear understanding of **project management fundamentals** and their role in delivering projects efficiently across agriculture, industry, transport, energy, infrastructure, and allied sectors.
- Understand **sustainability, ESG, and Net-Zero concepts in simple and practical terms**, and why they are increasingly critical for project design, execution, and long-term success.
- Gain clarity on **India's climate commitments, Net-Zero targets, and sector-wise emissions profile**, and their implications for organisations, project managers, and implementing agencies.
- Learn how to **integrate ESG principles (Environmental, Social, and Governance)** into project planning, implementation, monitoring, and reporting to achieve sustainable outcomes.
- Explore **proven tools, technologies, and best practices** that support emission reduction, resource efficiency, risk management, and improved project performance.
- Identify **practical pathways to design and deliver projects** that balance economic growth, environmental responsibility, social impact, and regulatory compliance.

A. Project Management Foundations

- Core principles and lifecycle of project management

- Fundamentals of sustainability and ESG and their relevance across agriculture, industry, transport, energy, and infrastructure sectors
- Overview of India's ESG regulatory landscape, including NGRBC and BRSR expectations
- Integrating ESG considerations into project planning, execution, monitoring, and reporting & managing environmental, social, and governance risks within projects

C. Net-Zero Transition & Sectoral Applications

- India's emissions profile, Net-Zero commitment, and sector-wise transition pathways
- Sustainable, climate-smart, and resource-efficient project practices to reduce emissions with Case studies and best practices demonstrating successful delivery of sustainable and Net-Zero projects across sectors, including agriculture
