1. ABOUT NPC

National Productivity Council (NPC) is an autonomous organization under the Department of Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade, Ministry of Commerce & Industry, Government of India. Rising incomes, rapidly growing but unplanned urbanization, and changing lifestyles have resulted in increased volumes and changing composition (increasing use of paper, plastic and other inorganic materials) of waste in India. Improper waste management in India has numerous implications on the environment and health. Besides paying attention to ameliorate the immediate environmental and public health crises resulting from the current state of solid waste management, there is also a need for articulating a long term strategy to address the future challenges of solid waste management in Indian cities. The challenges related to waste management in India are inefficient waste management by the Urban Local Bodies (ULBs), lack of segregation of waste, unsustainable packaging, lack of data collection mechanism & rising rural-urban conflicts. To address these issues, Government has taken several initiates regarding waste management like National Dashboard on elimination of single use plastic and Plastic waste management, Plastic waste management amendment rules, 2022, Mascot Pakriti, Project REPLAN etc. Waste is often viewed as useless, and waste collectors are often isolated. There is a need to change this perception and look at proper waste management. Hence, the idea of recovering all 'wealth' in the waste is essential to ensure proper waste management in the country. For this to work, recycling, reuse and recovery of energy and technology driven recycling is essential in an integrated approach towards waste management. The main abstract of the theme Waste to Wealth is to identify, develop and deploy technologies to treat waste to generate energy, recycle materials and extract worth.

- To impart knowledge to participants about effective uses of resources and minimizing wastes and doing our bit for Pollution Prevention;
- To enrich participants about latest waste management rules;
- To discuss with participants about environment protection measures, improved environment performance and improved productivity to their respective companies/organizations/Institutes would be covered;
- To promote 3Rs (Reduce, Reuse and Recycle) initiatives and dissemination of good practices, and facilitate integrated efforts towards achieving improvement in general health of city environment etc.
