These codes guarantee minimum wages for all segments, equal remuneration irrespective of gender, and periodic wage reviews to support living standards. Significant changes include widespread access to social security schemes (such as provident fund, insurance, and maternity benefits), coverage for gig and platform workers, formal employment procedures, and robust workplace safety guidelines. Dispute resolution will be expedited through streamlined tribunals, and companies will benefit from simplified registration and compliance systems. Together, these reforms aim to boost worker welfare, formalize employment, and enhance ease of doing business, while success depends on effective collaboration and enforcement by central and state governments.

3. LEARNING OBJECTIVES

This training program shall focus on equipping the participants on the various aspects of the new Labor Codes and its implementation in Organization. This training programme is going to delve into various aspects of the four newly designed codes and its implementation framework.

4. BROAD PROGRAM COVERAGE

The Training program shall tentatively cover the following aspects

- Understand the legislative background and objectives of the four new labor codes.
- Identify key provisions and compliance obligations under each code (Wages, Industrial Relations, Social Security, Occupational Safety).
- Analyze major differences between old labor laws and new codes, and the rationale for changes.
- Explain rights and responsibilities of employers and employees under the new regime.
- Apply knowledge to real-world scenarios—drafting compliant contracts, managing statutory contributions, handling disputes and audits.
- Develop HR and operations policies that meet new code requirements while promoting industrial harmony and productivity.
- Evaluate challenges and opportunities presented by implementation for various sectors and company sizes.

5. METHODOLOGY

The methodology of the training program would be participative in nature. The sessions would be based on conceptual deliberations, case studies, success stories and group exercises/discussions.
